We encourage you to attend your court hearing. It really increases your chances of keeping your home, and Housing Rights will be there to offer assistance.

### How can Housing Rights help me at court?

Housing Rights will have two specialist legal advisers at all High Court and County Court debt related possession hearings. If you have no representation, our advisers can offer free emergency advice and assistance, and if appropriate, accompany you at your hearing.

# Do I have to pay for this service?

This is a **FREE** service provided by Housing Rights. We are a charity, working to prevent homelessess in Northern Ireland.

#### What do I do next?

Go to your court hearing. When you get there, look out for the Housing Rights adviser (they will be wearing a badge with the Housing Rights logo). Go up and say hello, and they will look after you from there.
