More good quality homes to meet housing need

- At least 1,500 new social and 750 new affordable homes each year
- Ambitious targets for new social, affordable & private homes on surplus land
- A step-change in the delivery of shared housing

Good quality and affordable homes in the private rented sector

- Licensing of private landlords to raise standards
- Improving health and well-being through better housing
- Adequate financial support for private tenants in greatest need

A commitment to support people and tackle homelessness

- At least a 10% increase in Supporting People budget
- Government commitment to ending homelessness by 2022
- Make ending homelessness one of government's top 10 priorities
